About the Accelerator Program

The Accelerator Program is a free, 6-month public program designed for groups developing social purpose real estate projects in search of support through the pre-development phase of a project. This program is recommended for organizations ready to commit to the development of a specific project over the course of the program. Organizations must have either a confirmed concept or site that can be workshopped through this program.

Applications will be accepted until October 19, 2023.

All applicants will receive confirmation regarding the status of their application by **early November 2023.** The program will take place from **November 22, 2023 - May 15, 2024.**
